## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 94th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 487, L. D. 162, Bill, "An Act Relating to Mining."

Amend said bill by striking out all of the title thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:

'An Act to License Prospectors for Minerals and Metals.'

Further amend said bill by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

- 'Sec. 12. Application for prospector's license; fee. Any person 18 years of age or more who has been a resident of the state of Maine for more than 6 months may apply to the municipal officers of the city, town or plantation in which he is a resident for a prospector's license. Such application shall be accompanied by a fee of \$5.
- Sec. 13. Prospector's license; term. The said municipal officers, if satisfied that the applicant is of good moral character, may issue to him a prospector's license which shall be in force for a period of 3 years.
- Sec. 14. Permission to prospect. Any person to whom a prospector's license has been granted, as provided in section 12 and 13, may enter upon any of the wild lands or unimproved lands in the state and search for minerals and metals of any description; provided, however, that he shall not commit any damage upon said lands.'
