STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Judge and Recorder of the Town of Lincoln Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1947, c. 85, § 1, amended. The last sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 85 of the private and special laws of 1947 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$1,000 \$1,700 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1947, c. 85, § 1, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 85 of the private and special laws of 1947 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$300 \$1,100 a year to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Penobscot.'
