STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 18, § 6, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 6 of chapter 18 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'For a certificate under the seal of the state, \$1 for a short form and \$2 for a special detailed certificate; and for all copies at the rate of 50c a page if such copies are prepared by the office of the secretary of state and at the rate of 25c a page for proof-reading such copies submitted to the office of the secretary of state for certification. There shall be no charge for certificates or copies requested by any department of the state.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 18, § 6, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 6 of chapter 18 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'For recording contract of conditional sale of railroad equipment, \$10; ~~or~~ for recording written declaration of satisfaction of same, \$5; and for noting declaration of the satisfaction of such contract on the margin of the record, \$1.'
