STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Providing for Bridges and Culverts on Certain Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Construction and repair of bridges and culverts on certain roads. The state highway commission is hereby authorized and directed to expend the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, and the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, for the construction and repair of bridges and culverts on the unimproved portion of the Baxter State Park road, so called, from Millinocket lake to Sourdnahunk field, and the Roaring Brook road, so called, which leads from the Togue Pond Forks to Roaring brook. Those portions, however, for which state aid may be available are excepted from the provisions of this act.
