STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Apportionments from School Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 211-A, amended. Section 211-A of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 24 of chapter 350 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 211-A. Apportionments to be made in December; exception. All apportionments to cities and, towns, plantations, academies and institutes under the provisions of this chapter, unless specifically directed by statute, shall be made annually in December, except that whenever the commissioner of education is satisfied that a financial need exists, and with the approval of the treasurer of state, an amount not to exceed 2/3 of the estimated subsidy may be paid on or after September 15.'
