RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Morancy Pond, in the County of Hancock.

Regulating fishing in Morancy pond in the county of Hancock. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Morancy pond in the town of Sullivan, in the county of Hancock, to fishing through the ice for pickerel, hornpout, white perch, yellow perch, eets, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring and for all fish except bass during February, March and April.
