## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Relating to Order of Names on Primary Ballots.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 4, § 22, amended. The 4th sentence of section 22 of chapter 4 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The names of the candidates for nomination to each office shall be arranged under the designation of the office in alphabetical order, according to surnames in the order determined by lot at a public drawing to be conducted by the secretary of state on the Thursday following the 3rd Monday in April.'
