AN ACT Relating to Voting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 3, § 34-A, additional. Chapter 3 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 34-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 34-A. Failure to vote. Any person who fails to vote in any state-wide election, other than primary elections, shall not be permitted to vote in any election, state-wide or otherwise, for a period of 2 years thereafter.'
