RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Medway

Town of Medway; appropriation for. Resolved: That the balance of the money appropriated in favor of the town of Medway by the 93rd legislature for the fiscal year 1947-48 for repairing and planking the floor of the West Branch Penobscot bridge, so called, be and hereby is reappropriated in favor of the town of Medway to be expended for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, to aid in resurfacing the Powersville road, so called, starting near the residence of Everett Hale and proceeding north to end of road.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Medway had an appropriation of \$500 to use on the West Branch Penobscot bridge in 1947-48 but before they used much of it, the state took it over. The town used \$109.58, leaving a balance of \$390.42. The town would like to have this money reappropriated to be used on the Powersville road.
