STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Staff of the Governor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 12, § 9, amended. The 1st sentence of section 9 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 253 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The staff of the commander-in-chief shall consist of the adjutant-general, who shall be ex officio chief of staff, quartermaster-general and paymaster-general with rank of brigadier-general; the senior officer on duty with each of the staff departments; and such aides-de-camp not to exceed $\frac{1}{5}$ 9 in number, one of whom may be a naval aid aide with rank of captain, as may be appointed by the governor.'
