STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE in Favor of Winfield Paddock of Milo for Damage to Property.

Winfield Paddock; compensated for loss of property. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$3,558 to be paid to Winfield Paddock of Milo, as a full and final settlement against the state for loss of certain property caused by fire, which fire was set by a minor child boarded by the state: said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Winfield and Corinne Paddock's barn and contents thereof was burned almost completely on the afternoon of November 12, 1948. The fire was reputedly started by a minor child who was boarded by the state. The real property was not insured.
