AN ACT Excluding Television for Use in Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 33-A, additional. Chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 33-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 33-A. Television in motor vehicles excluded. No person shall drive any motor vehicle equipped with any television viewer, screen or other means of visually receiving a television broadcast which is located in the motor vehicle at any point forward of the back of the driver's seat, or which is visible to the driver while operating the motor vehicle.'
