AN ACT Relating to Chief Inspector of Utilities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 40, § 1, amended. The 5th sentence of section 1 of chapter 40 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The commission shall appoint a clerk and, subject to the provisions of the personnel law, an assistant clerk. ~~and also a chief inspector of utilities who shall be a practical railroad man and shall perform such duties as the commission may require.~~
