RESOLVE Regulating Smelt Fishing in Union River, Hancock County.

Smelt fishing in Union river; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation providing that it shall be lawful to take smelts in the Union river by angling with hook and line or by use of a dip net, but not otherwise, and establishing a daily limit in said river of 2 quarts of smelts per person per day.
