AN ACT Relating to Compensation for State Board of Arbitration and Conciliation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 10, amended. The 6th sentence of section 10 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Members of the board shall each receive ~~\$5~~ \$20 a day, for their services, for the time actually employed in the discharge of their official duties; they shall also receive their traveling and all other necessary expenses.'
