AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Portland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1891, c. 150, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 150 of the private and special laws of 1891, as amended by chapter 61 of the private and special laws of 1925 and by chapter 98 of the private and special laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 3. Salary increased.** The salary of the judge of said court shall be ~~\$3,000~~ \$3,500 per annum, beginning January 1st, ~~1945~~ 1949, in full for all services.'
