## AN ACT Relating to Lobster Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 34, § 115, amended.** The 3rd paragraph of section 115 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Such license shall be issued only to persons who have been, for  $\frac{10}{10}$  3 years immediately prior to the date of the application, legal residents of this state; provided, however, that any person who has previously been a legal resident of this state and has reestablished a legal residence here for a period of  $\frac{3}{3}$  years I year next preceding his application shall be entitled to have his non-residence taken as part of said  $\frac{10}{3}$  years, and the fee for such license shall be \$5.'
