**AN ACT Relating to Free Hunting and Fishing Permits for Certain
Veterans of World War II.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ VIII, amended. The 3rd sentence of subsection VIII of section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Such permits shall be issued only to veterans legally resident in Maine on July 1, 1947 **and only to those veterans who were inducted into the service prior to August 14, 1945** and all such permits shall expire on December 31, ~~1948~~ 1950.'
