STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Free Hunting and Fishing Permits for Certain Veterans of World War II.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ VIII, amended. The 3rd sentence of subsection VIII of section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Such permits shall be issued only to veterans legally resident in Maine on July 1, 1947 and only to those veterans who were inducted into the service prior to August 14, 1945 and all such permits shall expire on December 31, 1948 1950.'
