IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Spencer Lake in Somerset County.

Fishing in Spencer lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of not more than 15 fish or $7\frac{1}{2}$ pounds of trout, salmon or togue in Spencer lake in Somerset county.
