**RESOLVE, in Favor of State of Maine Building at Eastern States
Agricultural and Industrial Exposition.**

State of Maine Building; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund for the operation and maintenance of the State of Maine Building upon the grounds of the Eastern States Agricultural and Industrial Exposition, Inc., at West Springfield, Massachusetts, the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, and \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951; and be it further

Resolved: That the expenditure of such sums be under the control and direction of the building committee created under the provisions of chapter 51 of the resolves of 1923.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In the past sufficient revenues were derived to maintain the State of Maine Building in proper condition; however, such revenues have declined so that in order to maintain the building it is necessary that further money be appropriated.
