IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Railroad Crossing Signs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 69, amended. The first 2 sentences of section 69 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes are hereby repealed and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:

'Such signs shall be of such size, design and color as shall be established by an order or orders of the public utilities commission.'
