RESOLVE in Favor of F. Errol Littlefield of Hampden.

F. Errol Littlefield; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to F. Errol Littlefield, of Hampden, as a full and final settlement of all claims against the state for damage done to his property by the natural course of a stream being changed by the building of a diversion dam in the process of building a fishway, on Sourdabscook stream; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state built this fishway in 1935, and by changing the natural course of the stream, the water has worn away about an acre of land which would have been suitable for 3 cottage lots.

The 1941 legislature compensated Mrs. Littlefield \$400 for this damage.
