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**AN ACT Relative to Certain Implements and Devices Prohibited in  
Fishing.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 33, § 44, amended.** The 5th paragraph of section 44 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Any violation of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10, nor more than ~~\$30~~ \$300, and costs of prosecution, for each offense, and in addition thereto, \$1 for each fish unlawfully taken, caught, killed or in possession of any violator of this section.'
