STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Wholesale Lobster Dealer's License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 114, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 114 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The fee for a A license, designated as a wholesale lobster dealer's license, shall be \$50 and shall entitle the holder to buy and sell and transport fresh fish, shellfish and lobsters in wholesale trade within the state and to ship the same within and outside the state. If less than 100,000 pounds of such fresh fish, shellfish and lobsters are bought, sold and transported in any calendar year, the fee shall be \$25; if more than 100,000 pounds, the fee shall be \$50.'
