STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Canning of Quahogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 93, amended. Section 93 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 93. Canning of clams and mussels regulated. It shall be unlawful for any person to can any clams quahogs or mussels between the 1st day of June and the 30th day of the following September, both days inclusive, and it shall also be unlawful for any person to can at any time, either fresh or in salt, any clams quahogs or mussels dug or taken during the same period.

Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by the penalties provided in section 144 and in addition thereto \$1 for each bushel of clams guahogs or mussels involved.'
