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**AN ACT Relating to Maintenance of Bonny Eagle Bridge in the Town of  
Standish.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Bonny Eagle bridge in Standish; maintenance of.** The Bonny Eagle bridge, over the branch of the Saco river known as New river, on state route 35 in the town of Standish, county of Cumberland, shall hereafter be maintained by the state under direction of the state highway commission from funds provided for maintenance of bridges.
