RESOLVE in Favor of State Military Defense Commission.

---

**State Military Defense Commission; appropriation for. Resolved:**  
That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$350,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and the sum of \$350,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951 for the state military defense commission to carry out the purposes of sections 24 and 25 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

To complete construction of armories now under way and to cooperate with various cities and towns in the construction of new armories; and to support the policy of reorganization of the National Guard.

Supporting an agreed policy to aid in the expansion of property, storage and training facilities for the reserve companies of the armed forces, there is included in the federal budget for the support of the National Guard an item of \$40,000,000 for armory construction for each of the next 2 years. This money must be matched by funds available for armory construction at the state level.
