IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting of Deer in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 33, § 82, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 82 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘There shall be an annual open season on deer during the month of November in each calendar year in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoc, Waldo ~~Washington~~ and York. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season on deer.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 82, amended. Section 82 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph thereof, a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘There shall be an open season on deer in each calendar year beginning the 15th day of November and ending the 15th day of December, both dates inclusive, in the county of Washington. All the rest of the calendar year before and after the open season shall be a closed season on deer.’
