COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 831; L. D. 316, Bill "An Act Relating to Powers of Baxter State Park Authority."

Amend said bill by striking out in that part designated as "Sec. 31-C" thereof all after the 1st sentence, and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentences:

reasonable diligence be taken before the municipal court nearest to where the offense is alleged to have been committed, for a warrant and trial and in such case, jurisdiction is hereby granted to all municipal courts in adjoining counties to be exercised in the same manner as if the offense had been committed in that county. Provided, however, that if a trial justice whose usual place of holding court in the county where the offense is alleged to have been committed than is any municipal court, such violator may be taken before such trial justice for warrant and trial.'
