AN ACT to Authorize the Town of York to Construct a Public Wharf.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Town of York authorized to construct public wharf. The inhabitants of the town of York are hereby authorized to build, extend and maintain a public wharf in the waters of York river, in the county of York, said wharf to extend into the tidewaters of York river in a southwesterly direction a distance of 155 feet from the inland line to the low water mark in the channel and to extend from northwest to southeast a distance of 210 feet.
