HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 841, L. D. 336, Bill "An Act Relating
to Motor Vehicle Registration for Amputee
Veterans."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the 1st paragraph thereof
after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined
2nd paragraph thereof after the enacting clause and inserting in
place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'Provided, however, that the secretary of state, on application
for registration of any motor vehicle of any amputee veteran who
has been the recipient of an automobile from the United States
government under authority of P. L. 663, 79th Congress, as amended,
or any amputee veteran receiving compensation from the Veterans
Administration for service connected disability who shall have a
specially designed motor vehicle, and who is otherwise qualified
to operate a motor vehicle in this state, shall be entitled to
have said automobile so given to him duly registered and a regis-
tration certificate delivered to him without the requirement of
the payment of any fee.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting, before the last para-
graph thereof, the following paragraph:

'Sec. 2. Effective date, refunds. The provisions of this act
shall be retroactive to January 1, 1949. The secretary of state is
hereby authorized and directed to make such refunds as may be ap-
propriate to give effect to the provisions of this act.'
