HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 862, L. D. 338, Bill "An Act Relating
to Motor Vehicle Excise Tax for Amputee
Veterans."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the 1st paragraph thereof
after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined
2nd paragraph thereof after the enacting clause and inserting in
place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'Provided, however, that no amputee veteran who has been
the recipient of an automobile from the United States government
under authority of P. L. 663, 79th Congress, as amended, or any
amputee veteran receiving compensation from the Veterans Adminis-
tration for service connected disability who shall have a specially
designed motor vehicle, and who is otherwise qualified to operate
a motor vehicle in this state, shall not be required to pay the
annual excise tax or be otherwise in any way taxed for any one such
automobile so owned by him.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the Emergency
clause thereof the following paragraph:

'Sec. 2. Effective date; refunds. The provisions of
this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1949. Appropriate
officers of cities and towns are hereby authorized and directed to
make such refunds as may be necessary to give effect to the pro-
visions of this act.'
