IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Providing for a Fish Screen at Outlet of Cathance Stream and Bradley Pond.

Outlet of Cathance stream and Bradley pond; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,000 be, and hereby is appropriated from the legislative appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Cathance stream and Bradley pond in the town of Topsham in the county of Sagadahoc; provided, however, that said screen shall not be installed at the outlet of Cathance stream and Bradley pond until the Merrymeeting Bay Fishing Association shall assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There is a dam at the Cathance bridge and when the fish go over this dam they go into tidal waters.
