RESOLVE in Favor of the Town of Freeman.

Town of Freeman; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Freeman, the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, and the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, to aid in repairing the road leading from the Strong-Freeman town line to Foster hill, so called.
