AN ACT Relating to Funds Collected by the Potato Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 215, sub-§§III, IV, repealed and replaced. Subsections III and IV of section 215 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes are hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'III. The funds remaining over and above the expenses of carrying out the provisions of sections 206 to 217, inclusive, including the expenditures authorized under the provisions of subsection II shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account to be expended for the promotion of the potato industry in such manner and in such amounts as may be designated by the legislature.'
