STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Equipment in Official Inspection Garages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 36, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 36 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 186 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No application for a license to operate an official inspection station shall be considered unless the garage building to be used as an inspection station shall be of suitable length and width, shall have a level floor, shall be equipped with a screen or chart **or other equipment approved by the secretary of state** for the purpose of testing lights, and with tools and machinery necessary to make repairs to motor vehicles.'
