STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Annexing Certain Land to Brighton Plantation in Somerset County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain lands in Athens annexed to Brighton plantation. Such lands, which were set off from the town of Brighton and annexed to the town of Athens under the provisions of chapter 449 of the private and special laws of 1838 and chapter 184 of the private and special laws of 1862, are hereby set off from the town of Athens and annexed to the plantation of Brighton.
