STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Providing for Certain Construction at the Western Maine Sanatorium.

Western Maine sanatorium; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$50,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the state for construction of a dormitory for employees at the Western Maine sanatorium, and furnishings and other construction; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall be carried forward from year to year until such time as the building is constructed and the work completed; and be it further

Resolved: That this construction shall begin as soon as practicable and upon approval of the governor and council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This department recommends the construction of a small dormitory for employees and also suggests that this resolve also cover the remodeling of a former children's building at this institution to provide rooms for 12 patients, at an estimated cost of \$9,000 to \$10,000.
