IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Terms of Employment for Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 78, sub-§ V, amended. The 1st sentence of subsection V of section 78 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'He shall nominate all teachers subject to such regulations governing salaries and the qualifications of teachers as the superintending school committee shall make, and upon the approval of nominations by said committee, he may employ teachers so nominated and approved for such terms, not to exceed 5 years, as he may deem proper, subject to the approval of the school committee; except that after a probationary period of 2 years in any town, subsequent terms in such town shall be for not less than 3 years.'
