## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Licenses for Amputee Veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 48, amended. Section 48 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 247 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that the secretary of state, on application of any amputee veteran who has been the recipient of an automobile from the United States government under authority of P. L. 663, 79th congress, as amended, and who is otherwise qualified to operate a motor vehicle in this state, shall receive a license to operate such automobile without the requirement of the payment of any fee.'
