STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing Licenses for Persons Over Eighty Years of Age.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 33, § 32, sub-§ X, additional. Section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered X, to read as follows:
 - 'X. A permit to fish shall be issued, free of charge, to every resident of the state who has reached the age of 80 years. Such permit shall be valid for the remainder of the licensee's life.'
