## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to the Possession of Partridge and Pheasants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 75, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 75 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

There shall be a closed season on partridge or grouse and pheasant from November 16th to September 30th of the following year, both days inclusive, and no person shall, during the open season, have in possession in any 1 day more than 4 partridge or 2 pheasants or not more than 4 partridge and pheasants in the aggregate, or in any 1 open season for partridge or grouse more than 25 partridge or 12 pheasants, nor shall any person at any time buy or sell any partridge, grouse or pheasant. No person shall have in possession any partridge or pheasants taken in closed season.'
