RESOLVE Regulating Fishing in Spruce Pond in the County of Somerset.

Regulating fishing in Spruce pond in the county of Somerset. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation reducing in Spruce pond in Limington plantation, in the county of Somerset, the daily bag limit to 6 trout or not more than 5 pounds per person per day.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is a very small pond and is being heavily fished. The reduction of bag limits is necessary, otherwise fishing will soon be depleted.
