STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Guides.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 72, amended. The last sentence of section 72 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No guide shall be employed by more than three 4 non-residents while hunting at the same time.'
