STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of State Park Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32, § 23, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 23 of chapter 32 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each member shall be paid the sum of \$5 \$10 per diem for the time actually spent by each in transacting official business of the commission, payment to be made as hereinafter provided for.'
