STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Mayor of the City of Saco.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1867, c. 215, § 3, amended. The last sentence of section 3 of chapter 215 of the private and special laws of 1867, as amended by section 1 of chapter 226 of the private and special laws of 1907, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

The salary and compensation of the mayor shall be six hundred dollars \$1,500 per year which shall not be increased or diminished during his continuance in office, unless by the vote of the qualified electors in ward meetings called for that purpose, nor shall be receive from the city any other compensation for any services by him rendered in any other capacity or agency; provided however, the city council may elect the mayor to any city office, and allow him reasonable compensation for services rendered in such office; but the. The aldermen and common council shall not be entitled to receive any salary or compensation for any services by them performed as such.
