RESOLVE Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Lands in Oxford County to Emile Pellerin of Rumford.

State tax assessor authorized to convey land. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Emile Pellerin, of Rumford, whatever interest the state has in the H. H. Hutchins lot, bounded N. by Rumford; E. by W. E. Bean; S. and W. by Asa Sessions; in Milton Township, Oxford county, containing 100 acres, more or less, for the sum of \$46.57.

This property became state owned through matured tax lien in 1948. Mr. Pellerin, the former owner of the property, has deposited with the bureau of taxation the sum of \$46.57, which covers all accrued taxes and the estimated tax for 1949, as well as interest and costs.
