IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Transferring Supervision and Control of Certain Interest of the State in Lands in the Unorganized Territory from the State Tax Assessor to the Forest Commissioner.

State tax assessor authorized to convey land. Resolved: That supervision and control of the interest of the state in the following described properties be and hereby is transferred from the state tax assessor to the forest commissioner:

9, R. 5, W. E. L. S., Aroostook county

S. part section 31, according to plan by Daniel Barker in 1864, containing 382 acres, more or less.

6, N. D., Washington county

Hardwood island, in Grand lake, in N. part of said township, according to plan by H. R. Taylor, containing 50 acres, more or less.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These parcels appear to be state owned by reason of tax titles. They were included in the report of state owned delinquent tax lands tendered to the 93rd legislature. No action toward their disposal was taken in 1947. It is recommended that these lots be retained by the state, and for that reason that they be transferred to the control of the forest commissioner.
