STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Wild Bees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 118, § 43, additional. Chapter 118 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 43, to read as follows:

Protection of Wild Bees

Sec. 43. Wild bees protected; penalty. No person shall capture, destroy or interfere with a colony or nest of wild bees or remove honey from same.

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10, nor more than \$50, for each offense.'
